

Testing Your Broadband Speed

"How do I check what speed broadband I have?"

There should be something on the bill from a broadband provider which says what service you are paying for. If you look up that specific service/package on the provider's website you will be able to see the advertised speed, i.e. the maximum speed the line will support.

Actual speed will vary, due to various factors, not least contention, which is other people sharing the line.
