The Role

The Clinical Manager plays a key role in ensuring the quality, integrity, and effectiveness of MyMind's service. This position oversees clinical governance, supports our mental health professionals, and contributes to strategic and operational planning to maintain excellence in client care.

Core Responsibilities

- Provide clinical support and oversight to operations staff
- Oversee clinical policies and procedures.
- Review service processes, recommending improvements based on evidence-based practices.
- Monitor and follow up on incident reports as required.
- Ensure compliance with all relevant regulatory, accreditation, and professional standards
- Conduct quarterly clinical reviews of MyMind mental health professionals
- Manage CPD and peer support systems for mental health professionals
- Support with clinical interviews and onboarding for mental health professionals.

- Design of the research with outcomes
- Engagement with reporting processes agreed with the management team
